

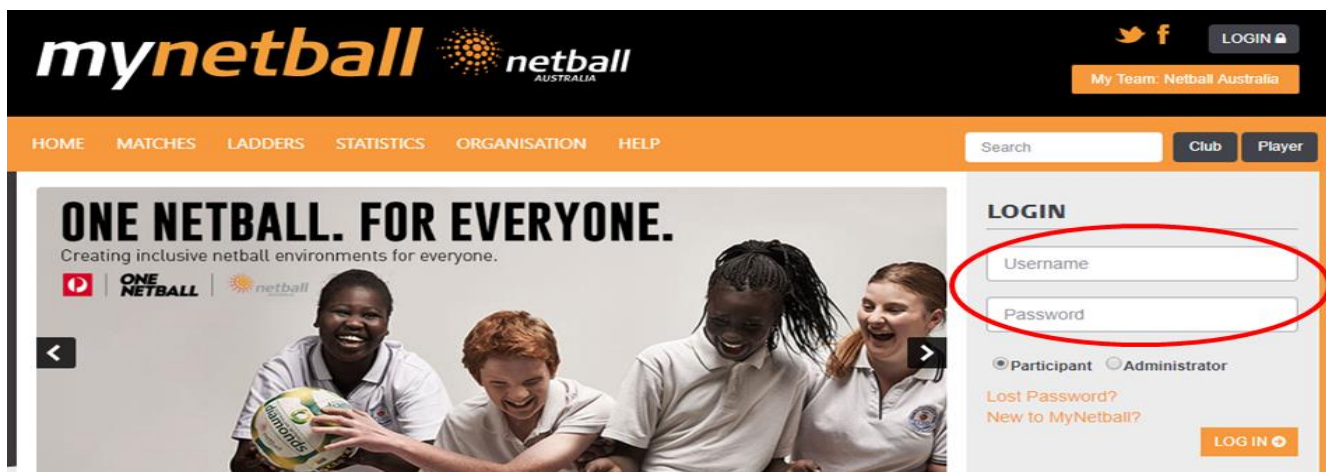
Quick Reference Guide: Accreditation Updating Process (if accreditation has been expired for >12 months)

Accreditations that have been expired for longer than 12 months are unable to be updated via Netball Australia's online updating system.

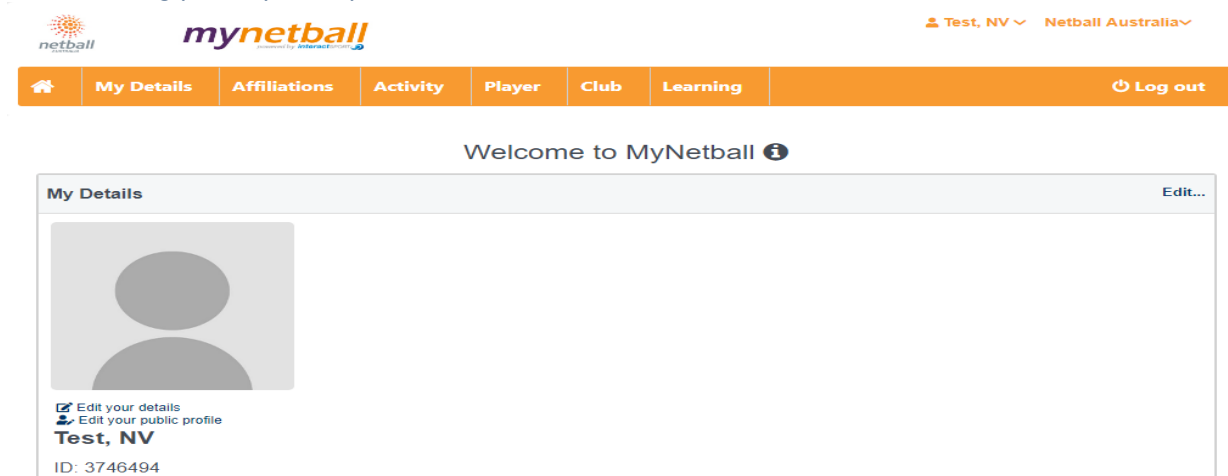
This document explains the process you need to follow to update an accreditation has been expired for more than 12 months.

Steps:

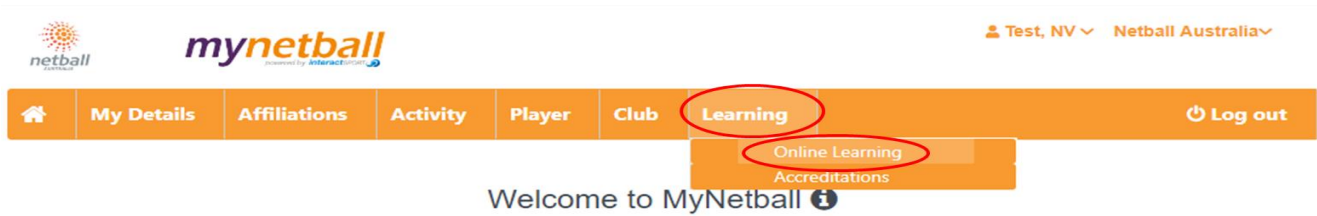
1. Visit my.netball.com.au to bring you to the MyNetball website.
2. Enter your log-in details and proceed to your account.



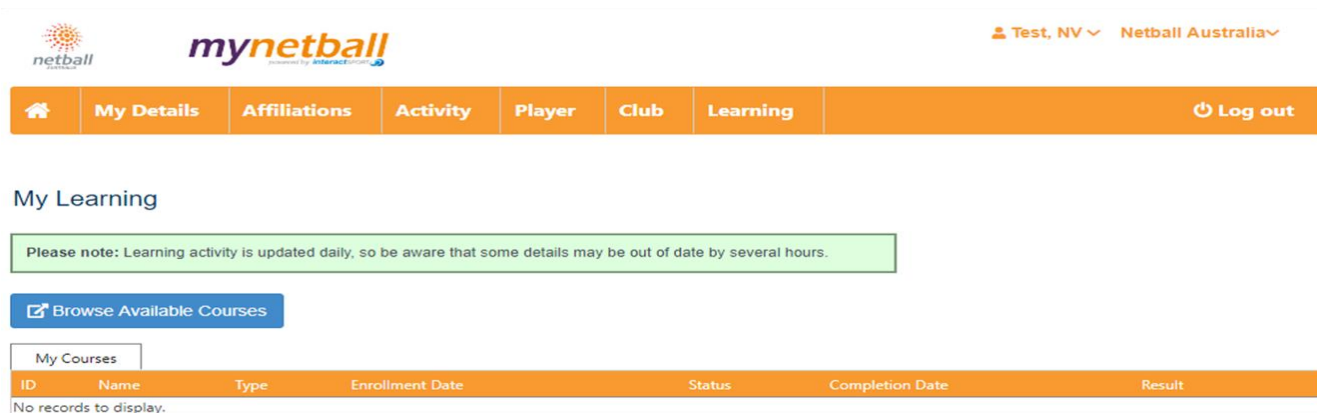
This will bring you to your [MyNetball Profile](#).



3. Move mouse over the **Learning** tab and then click **Online Learning** in the drop-down list that appears.



This will bring you to the [My Learning](#) page.



4. Click **Browse Available Courses** to see what courses are available.



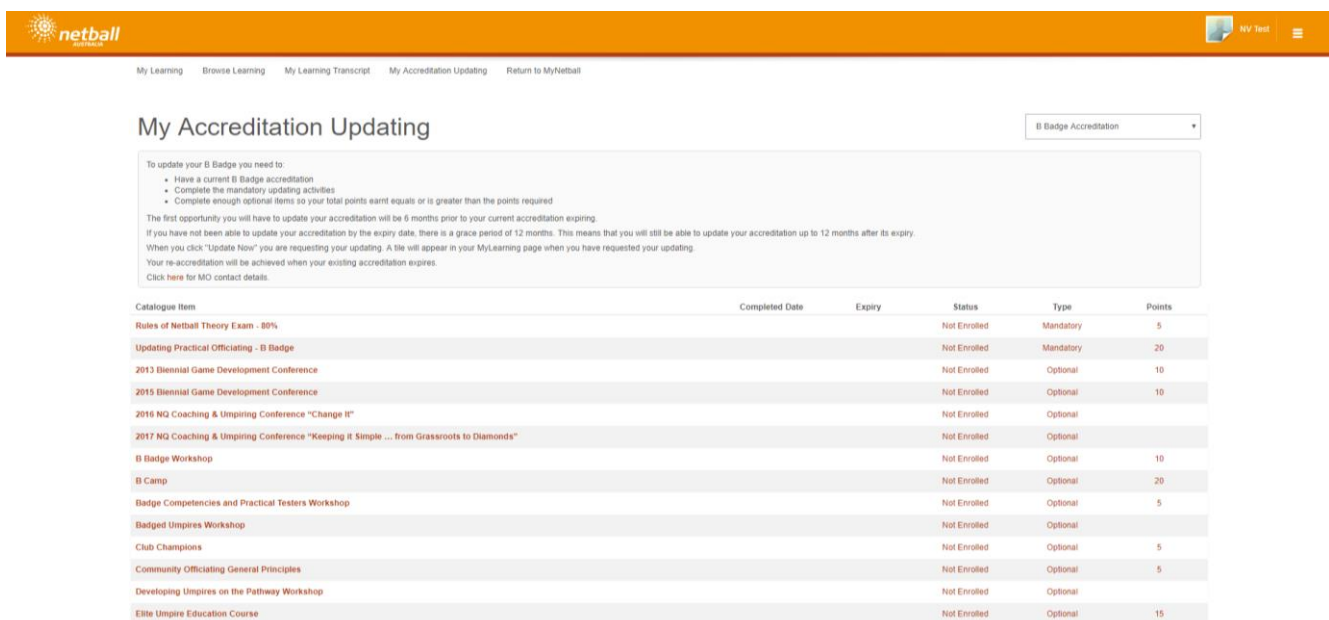
5. Once you are looking at the full catalogue, click **My Accreditation Updating** menu.



6. Select your accreditation in the drop-down list to the right of the screen.



Once you select the accreditation you are wanting to update, the screen that should come up will have a list of every learning course/activity that you can complete to contribute to your points.



A. Please note that this list has many State specific courses that are unavailable to Netball Victoria members.

B. At the top of the list will be the 2 mandatory requirements, the Rules of Netball Theory Exam & the Updating Practical Officiating for your badge level.

PLEASE NOTE: If they are red instead of green, click on them to launch them to complete.

- D. If you are struggling to make up the points, on page 2 of the list there are 7 PBTR (Play by the Rules) courses that are worth 5 points each as well as an area for an additional 5 practical umpiring points (5 points = 5 hours of umpiring) for C & B Badge umpires.





Netball Australia C Badge Umpire Accreditation is valid for four (4) years. The period starts when a Netball Australia certificate of accreditation is issued.

Points to be completed: 20 (Minimum practical component: 10 hours 1 point = 1 hour)

Note: please total the number of hours of practical umpiring and enter as one event only (maximum 10 points)
