Central East Association Championships

Welcome to the 2021 Origin Association Championships. After no competition in 2020, we are excited to (finally) welcome you back. This information should assist you in preparation for the day and we ask that all relevant information is shared to your coaches, team managers and players.

Host Association: Waverley District Netball Association

Venue Address: Cassinia Avenue, Ashwood

Parking: Ample parking is available via Cassinia Avenue. Please ensure you follow instructions from the parking attendants to ensure you are in the right zone.

Two drop off zones have been allocated; one in the carpark off Cassinia Avenue and the other on Cassinia Avenue with access directly into the courts. Please drop off at the relevant zone according to your division.

Venue Capacity Limits

The maximum venue capacity is 300 people.

In order to stay within the venue capacity limit of 300, a maximum of 14 people are permitted per team. The composition of the 14 is at the discretion of the competing association/league. An example is as follows based on the information supplied with team entries:

Players	11
Coaches	1
Team Manager	1
Scorer	1

Whilst no spectators are permitted, parents/guardians are permitted to attend to support the participation of a child. However, parents/guardians are included within the venue capacity. Therefore, if your team requires a parent for support (ie. medical condition) it is recommended a role is allocated, for example scorer. If you have additional places available due to lower player numbers, you may allocate access to parent/guardians.

Wristbands will be allocated to all adult attendees (coaches, team managers, scorers etc) to monitor attendance numbers. Anyone without a wristband will be asked to leave the venue. The distribution of the wristbands will be managed by the association/league on the day. The wristbands will be supplied upon team entry.

Please note any dependents required to attend will be included within your 14.

Spectators

Due to current Victorian Government guidelines, no spectators are permitted within the venue. We ask that you communicate this to all parents/guardians, aunties, uncles, grandparents and partners.

Please note this also includes additional association/league personnel who are unable to be counted within the 14 people per team.

We ask that parents/guardians don't set up 'outside' of the venue to view the courts. This may compromise our venue numbers and result in either fines or the event being suspended.

Team Check In

Reserve Division:

All teams are required to check in at the allocated location between 8.00am – 8.30am.

Please nominate one person to check in your team on arrival.

Players and officials in the Reserve Division must not arrive prior to 8am.

Championship Division:

All teams are required to check in at the allocated location between 8.30am – 9.00am.

Please nominate one person to check in your team on arrival.

Players and officials in the Championship Division must not arrive prior to 8:30am.

Origin Bib Patches

All teams will be supplied with a set of stick on Origin logos for their team bibs. Please ensure you stick these onto both the back and front bibs prior to your first match.

The logos will stick on for the day and can be removed easily afterwards.

Team Changes

Any approved team changes must be updated with Netball Victoria upon check in. This will ensure TID staff have accurate lists available.

If a player is replaced, please do not use their TID number and instead mark their leg with their allocated number on the team list supplied.

QR Code Check In

All attendees (players, coaches, team managers, umpires and scorers) must check in via the Service Victoria QR Code. A copy is below and also attached. We encourage you to share this to allow for an early check in.

COVID Protocols

Please see attached for the COVID protocols, in conjunction with the COVID Safe Plan, which will be implemented during this tournament. It is important you comply with all of these points and share with the applicable personnel.

Anyone experiencing symptoms must not attend.

Masks

As per Victorian Government guidelines, a mask must be worn at all times unless involved in physical activity. This includes coaches and players who are not on the court.

A strict no mask, no entry policy will be applied upon entry. Any team not complying during the day may forfeit their match.

GEARLOCK

Netball Victoria will apply GEARLOCK™, a 12HR equipment and surface protectant, to all match balls and goal post padding. GEARLOCK™ disinfects surfaces and then dries to form a long-lasting protective barrier that provides up to 12hrs of continuous defence against bacteria.

Fixtures

Fixtures will be available by Thursday, 5 August online via MyNetball. This may be altered on the day of competition due to unforeseen circumstances.

It is recommended you encourage all officials to download the MyNetball app to view fixtures. Add Netball Victoria as the Clubs and associations.

Four (4) minutes has been allocated between each match. Please ensure you arrive at your court in time for your match and leave immediately after your match. Social distancing must be maintained at all times.

Venue Layout

Please refer to the map attached for the venue layout.

To allow the competition to go ahead, the venue has been divided into two spaces. Championship Division have been allocated the four (4) courts and Reserve Division the eight (8) courts.

Please ensure you stay within your allocated space. The crossover of spaces is not permitted except for Waverley District Netball Association staff and volunteers, Netball Victoria staff including umpire coaches and TID scouts and umpires.

Marquees

No marquees are permitted to be erected. Teams are encouraged to bring picnic blankets and chairs to sit between matches.

Scoring

Each team must provide a scorer per match. The scorers from each team must stand together (socially distanced) and use the official scoresheet supplied.

No player names are required on the scoresheet. Goals must be recorded and tallied for both teams. No signatures are required.

The winning team must bring the scoresheet to the allocated competition office per space at the conclusion of the match.

Ladders

No ladders will be printed during the tournament and will be available via MyNetball.

Parents are encouraged to download the MyNetball app to keep track of results during the day.

Umpires

Please ensure your umpire arrives by 8:30am to check in. Payment of the umpire is the responsibility of the association/league.

There is a \$250 fine for not supplying an umpire on the day of competition.

TID

Netball Victoria will have TID Scouts during the tournament viewing all matches. All players should have a number on their leg which corresponds with the team list submitted. Players who have been identified will receive notification following the competition in August 2021.

Finals

Finals will be played in all divisions between the top 4 teams.

Semi Finals – 1 Pool A v 2 Pool B and 2 Pool A v 1 Pool B

Grand Final – Winner of 1 Pool A v 2 Pool B and winner of 2 Pool A v 1 Pool B

A presentation will be made following all grand finals. Players are encouraged to stay in their uniform or association/league tracksuit including shoes.

Note: pending venue numbers, teams may be permitted one (1) parent/guardian for grand finals. This will be dependent on teams leaving the venue in a timely manner. Netball Victoria will communicate this to qualifying teams on the day of competition. A group chat is recommended to pass on this message to parent/guardians.
