

Once you have addressed the steps outlined in [Netball Victoria's Child Safeguarding Introductory Pack](#), your organisation can begin developing a child safeguarding action plan.

An action plan allows you organisation to identify the areas within your organisation that are not complying with the 11 Child Safety Standards and develop a plan to address these areas.

To begin your Child Safety Action Plan, move through the steps below.

1: Ensure that you have completed/begun addressing the steps outlined in [Netball Victoria's Child Safeguarding Introductory Pack](#) and have attended/watched the recording of [Netball Victoria's Child Safeguarding Webinar Series: Introduction to the 11 Child Safety Standards](#).

2: Ensure that you have either attended/watch the recording of [Netball Victoria's Child Safeguarding Webinar Series: Developing an Action Plan](#)

2: Complete the [Child Safety Progress Review](#) with your organisations committee.

3: Complete the [Child Safety Comprehensive Review](#) with your organisations Child Safety Sub-committee and ensure that you include/consult a cross-section of your netball community in your review.

- Where possible, consult the following members within your organisation.
 - Committee/board member
 - Staff (from all levels)
 - Coach
 - Official/Umpire
 - Volunteer
 - Participants from different age brackets
 - U18 – with approval of parent/guardian (i.e, your organisations Youth Advisory Committee)
 - 18+
 - Parent

4: Develop your [Child Safety Action Plan](#).
