## **Integrity in Netball Framework**

Netball Victoria is committed to working with Netball Australia to implement the Integrity in Netball Framework and associated Rules that include Illicit Drugs; Supplements and Other Substances; Medications; No Self Injection; Anti-Doping Declaration; and Reporting Conduct that may bring Netball into Disrepute.

As per VNL Competition Regulation 2.8 (Integrity Framework) and, in compliance with the Netball Australia Integrity Framework, all athletes and officials <u>must complete these requirements by two weeks prior Round 1 of the 2024 season</u>. You are only required to complete these modules once, unless there is an update which will be communicated. The <u>Sport Integrity Australia Annual Update needs to be completed each year</u>.

Players will need to create their own login and password. All courses can be found at <a href="https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au/">https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au/</a>

All Certificates or proof of completion must be submitted by athletes to their club. Clubs will provide Netball Victoria with a statutory declaration confirming all athletes and officials have completed all requirements.

Athletes and officials who have completed the requirements in 2023 (or recent years) will not need to do them again, however, will need to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Annual update.

Failure to complete all Integrity Framework Requirements will result in player quarters not counting towards finals qualifications.

Officials who have not completed the requirements will not be permitted to sit on the bench.

Second-time offences will result in a fine.
