Tenure, Hours and Salary	<p>Casual</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is a casual position working up to 4 hours per week during Victorian school terms. • Hourly rate is based on Coaching qualifications and experience • Up to 4 Sunday tournaments throughout the year are paid on a set daily or half daily rate, depending on the tournament. Not all age levels attend Tournaments. • A timesheet will be submitted weekly to the Rep Program Coordinator

Location	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training - Duncan MacKinnon Reserve – Corner of North Rd and Murrumbeena Rd, Murrumbeena. • Games - Jells Park in Waverley • Tournaments – various locations; generally, in Melbourne and regions.

Key Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CDNA Coaches will focus on the development of a player’s netball skills, promote fair play and sportsmanship. • Be positive, inclusive and develop players for maximum performance. • Plan and run weekly training sessions, attend all matches and warm up the players a minimum of 30 minutes before each game. • All Coaches must be available to attend all team training on Mondays unless otherwise designated by the Rep Coordinator. Where coaches are unavailable, they must organize a replacement coach with the Rep Coordinator with advanced notice. • Show a commitment to improving their own coaching abilities. The predominant role of coaches will be the planning and running of training sessions and coaching their team at matches and tournaments accordingly • The coach will abide by the CDNA Code of Conduct.
Position Tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure that players are provided with direct learning at a practical level through individual, specialist and team coaching instruction • Coach is to prepare and execute weekly training sessions accordingly • Introduce players to varied approaches to learning • Determine in consultation with the Rep Coordinator coaching requirements for the team • Develop, implement and adapt match play strategies • Provide coaching instruction to players in the areas of technique, positional skills and team skills • Evaluate and assess individual and team performance, ensuring individuals are appropriately challenged and provided with constructive feedback • Take appropriate action to ensure underperformance is effectively dealt with • Abide by Association/Club Policies and Procedures
