Responsibilities

The Head Coach role will consist of coach mentoring, development of training and game day strategies and player management and engagement.

Key responsibilities are outlined below:

Coach Mentoring

- Mentor the coaches, during training and game day, to help with their development.
- The club is committed to coach development and will fund our coaches development through the Netball Victoria coaching pathway. As mentor, allow them to put into practice the skills learned through the various coaching courses.

Develop and implement training strategies

- Working with the coaches, develop appropriate training strategies and drills, in line with the team/players needs and abilities.
- Provide the necessary resources/guidance/feedback to the coaches to ensure they understand and can implement the recommended strategies and drills on match day.
- Provide real time feedback to the coaches during training so they can further develop their skills.
- Foster an environment where the coaches' own strategies can be refined and developed to meet the needs to the team/players.
- Training overview:
 - One training session per week, approximately 1 hour duration
 - We anticipate approximately 100 players will attend training each week across different age groups.
 - Training is currently scheduled for Thursdays 4.00pm-6:00pm

Game Day Mentoring

- Watch and analyse the games, providing real time feedback directly to the coaches on relevant team strategies and player feedback.
- Use the learnings from match day to formulate training strategies.
- Game overview:
 - Games are played through the Parkville Netball Association competition.
 - Engage with all players, regardless of ability, to ensure everyone feels included and has the opportunity to develop.

Also, to assist with player grading and pre-season training.

Responsibilities

We are looking for someone who is knowledgeable with netball strategies and drills and who can confidently engage and mentor our coaches and players, regardless of age and ability.

A key responsibility would also to be developing and sourcing coaches as the club expands to ensure that each team has a dedicated coach to help with player development.

A coaching qualification and adequate coaching experience is preferred. Previous experience will be highly regarded.
