- Assist with the management of trials and selection process for the Alexandra Football/Netball Club.
- Prepare and oversee the pre-season calendar.
- Coach the A Grade team in accordance with the competition requirements relating to the OEFNL.
- Plan and implement a training program to prepare the A Grade team for the 2025 Season.
- Be responsible for the players whilst training and playing.
- Be a role model and ambassador for the AFNC.
- Work alongside the committee, senior and junior coordinators and other coaches and netball staff.
