Position Purpose

The Head Netball Coach provides strategic and hands-on leadership to the netball program at UTFNC.

This role oversees player and coach development across all grades — from Under 17s through to Senior competition — to ensure a consistent, positive, and high-quality coaching environment that supports both performance and participation.

Key Responsibilities

Leadership and Program Development

- Lead the overall direction, strategy, and culture of the UTFNC netball program.
- Support the development of a clear player and coach pathway from Under 17s through to Senior competition.
- Collaborate with the Netball Coordinators and Executive Committee to set goals and monitor progress.
- Foster a positive, inclusive, and safe team culture consistent with UTFNC's values and Child Safe Standards.

Coaching and Player Development

- Develop and deliver structured, engaging, and progressive training programs for senior and/or squad-level players.
- Mentor and support team coaches across all grades, providing regular feedback, professional learning, and encouragement.
- Identify player development needs and coordinate appropriate support (e.g. specialist sessions, strength and conditioning, or individual mentoring).
- Promote fair play, team cohesion, and strong communication between players, coaches, and parents.

Selection and Game Management

- Oversee player selection processes in collaboration with team coaches and selectors, ensuring fairness and transparency.
- Support match-day strategy and coaching across senior teams where required.
- Drive tactical consistency and game-style alignment across all grades to support player progression.

Administration and Communication

- Attend and contribute to relevant club and committee meetings.
- Provide regular updates on player development, team performance, and program needs.
- Liaise with Netball Coordinators regarding player recruitment, training schedules, and facility use.
- Support the organisation and delivery of trials, pre-season training, and information sessions.
