- Communicate positively with players and parents, providing regular feedback on performance and development.
- Work collaboratively with other coaches within the Rep program, particularly within your age group.
- Attend Rep Squad trials and support squad selection.
- Attend the annual player induction meeting.
- Provide updates on team progress and contribute suggestions for program improvement when requested.
