



2026 Netball Victoria School Championships

School Championship Date and Team Registrations

School Championship Team Entries will be completed this year via Netball Connect. Register to the day(s) your school wishes to attend to secure your spot before maximum capacity is reached. If your preferred day is sold out, you may register for an alternative date. Netball Victoria will not be allocating Schools via preferences; the link you register through determines the day that team is scheduled to attend.

Round 1 start time: 10.00am

Finish Time: Between 2:30-3.00pm (dependent on team entries)

Invoicing and Date Changes

All schools will receive an invoice, and payment is due by **5:00pm Monday 6 July 2026**.

- Teams withdrawing after 30 June 2026, will be required to pay a \$100 administration fee per team (\$30 refund/credit per team will be given*).
- Schools withdrawing teams less than 14 days before their scheduled preliminary day, **will not receive any refund of their entry fee.**

*Not applicable for Early Bird Entries.

Any changes to entry details, or team withdrawals must be emailed to us as soon as possible. Please notify us if your preferred day is sold out and you wish to join the waitlist.

Fixtures

Fixtures will be available two (2) days prior to your school's competition date online on Netball Connect. This may be altered on the day of competition due to unforeseen circumstances.

- We strongly encourage teachers, coaches and parents to download the Netball Connect App to view fixtures. We will also send a link to fixtures once they are published.

Umpires

If your school is providing their own umpire, they must be **minimum C badge and hold a current WWCC**. The umpire/s names must be provided **at least two weeks prior** to your preliminary date, a link will be sent out in 2026 for you to complete umpire details.

- Please ensure your umpire arrives by 9:30am to check in. Payment of the umpire is the responsibility of the school.

There is a \$250 fine for not supplying an umpire on the day of competition.

Finals Qualifications, Dates and Umpires

All finals will be held at the State Netball Centre, Parkville. Your school qualifies for finals day if they finish on top of their division. The Finals Day dates are available on the Netball Victoria website.

Finals Days will cost **\$140 per team** to cover Umpires – which Netball Victoria will supply.
