Position Purpose

- Foster a positive, inclusive and high-performance team environment.



- Encourage teamwork, accountability, respect and commitment.
- Provide constructive feedback and support player development throughout the season.
- Work collaboratively with the B Grade Coach and club committee to support player development across the A/B squad.
- Maintain a strong focus on player wellbeing, safety and appropriate conduct.
- Represent North Geelong Netball Club positively and professionally.

Applicants must:

- Be available for **Thursday night training and Saturday game days** throughout the 2027 season.
- Hold a **current Working with Children Check (WWCC)**.
- Hold a minimum **Development Coaching accreditation** or equivalent recognised coaching qualification.
- Demonstrate a strong understanding of netball fundamentals, team structures and game strategy.
- Demonstrate a commitment to developing players and creating a positive team culture.

- Has previous experience coaching senior or A Grade netball.
